Math	<p>Practice your multiplication math facts.</p> <p>Options:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Imagine Math • Splash Math • Flash Cards • Roll 2 dice and multiply the number. • Draw 2 cards and multiply the numbers. • Exact Path Math
Science	<p>Have daily challenges!</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Go outside and weed the garden. Measure the roots to the nearest inch. • Go on a bird/leaf hunt. Identify as many creatures and growing things as you can.
Social Studies	<p>Literacy Pro: Read <u>Caves</u> and do the quiz after it.</p> <p>Visit the Famous Missourian Webpage (On Classroom Google).</p> <p>Research someone new and send your teacher an email with 2-3 fun facts.</p>
