Content Area	Learning Challenge
Reading	Read a book, newspaper article, Tumblebook, or Scholastic Literacy Pro book of your choice and summarize it to a family member. Remember to read aloud and practice your reading fluency!!
Writing	 Write an email to your teacher about your day. Remember to use correct capitalization and punctuation. Practice writing your full name in cursive. Have mom or dad take a picture of your writing and email it to your teacher. (Just for fun!)
Math	Practice your multiplication math facts. Options: Imagine Math Splash Math Flash Cards Roll 2 dice and multiply the number. Draw 2 cards and multiply the numbers. Exact Path Math
Science	 Have daily challenges! Go outside and weed the garden. Measure the roots to the nearest inch. Go on a bird/leaf hunt. Identify as many creatures and growing things as you can.
Social Studies	Literacy Pro: Read <u>Caves</u> and do the quiz after it. Visit the Famous Missourian Webpage (On Classroom Google). Research someone new and send your teacher an email with 2-3 fun facts.
