The Morgan County School District is committed to transparency as we communicate to our school community and the public during the COVID-19 pandemic. However, it does take time to ascertain the facts and details of a reported case when we learn about it. We ask your patience as we work to first take care of the individuals who test positive and anyone with which they may have come into close contact.

We have developed a chart that will list the number of confirmed cases by students and staff and those who have or are quarantined. The chart will be updated daily by noon.

Morgan County R-1 will report positive cases to the local health departments and relies on their guidance. Although the district discloses case information to the area health departments, we must maintain confidentiality for the individual who tests positive. To assist us in mitigating cases, please remember the 3 W's:

- 1. Wash your hands
- 2. Wear your mask
- 3. Watch your distance

Please help us ensure our population is as healthy as possible by screening your students. Before sending them out the door every morning, ask these important questions:

- 1. Do you have a fever?
- 2. Do you have a new cough?
- 3. Have you experienced nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea?
- 4. Do you have a sore throat?
- 5. Do you have a headache?
- 6. Have you lost your sense of smell or taste?
